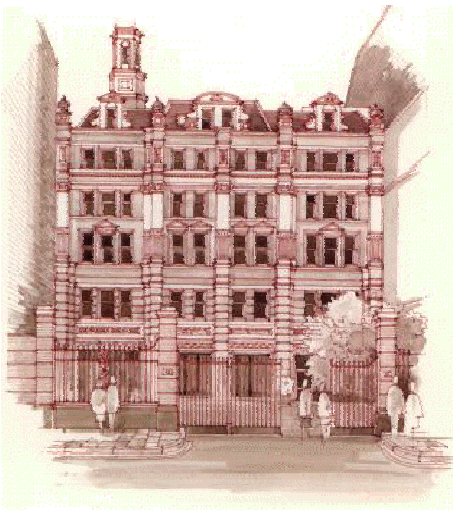
Warren Edwardes, chairman of ASDW, will present a *Winter Warmers* wine tasting, a selection of ASDW members' wines.

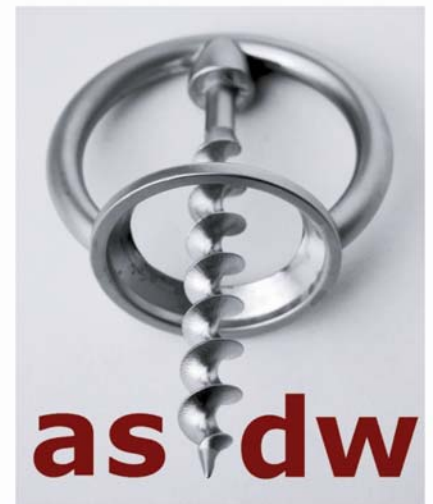
